Tracey Stewart from Lafayette Instrument will also be present to give a short presentation on the latest features of the Lafayette polygraph system to include the changes in software and use of the PLE.

Date & Time: The seminar date is Friday November 2nd, 2018, from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. A short business meeting will be held after lunch to receive new applicants and elect new officers.

Location: The seminar will be conducted at the Arvada Police Department Community Station at 6644 Kendrick Drive, Arvada, CO 80007-7016. This is in the western portion of Arvada. See enclosed map.

Speakers:

Dr. Bartels has a Masters and a Doctorate in clinical psychology from University of Denver. She specializes in Forensic Psychology. She has been a member of the CO SOMB and a treatment provider and clinical supervisor for adults and children.

Dr. Tindall has a Doctorate of Psychology and a Master of Arts from University of Denver. She has provided treatment for individuals in the criminal justice system for psychosexual offense specific evaluations, trauma assessments and other psychological evaluation.

This training will consist of the following issues:

- Vicarious Trauma for people working in law enforcement and related professions, due to continuous exposure to victims of trauma and violence. Exposure can occur from listening to victims, suspects, looking at videos of violence or exploited children and responding to mass violence incidents resulting in injuries and deaths.
- Career Traumatic Stress and risk factors in dealing with sexual offenders and the criminal element.
- Self-assessment of related stress levels, resilience and coping styles in the work place.
- Stress involving business decisions, threatening situations, stress tolerance.
- Choosing the most rational way of handling stress.

Cost: Free to members and applicants; \$50.00 for non-members.

6644 Kendrick Dr/Arvada PD Westwood Sub Station.

If taking I-70, exit Ward Rd north to W. 64th Ave. West on 64th Av to north on Kendrick Dr. Station on the right.

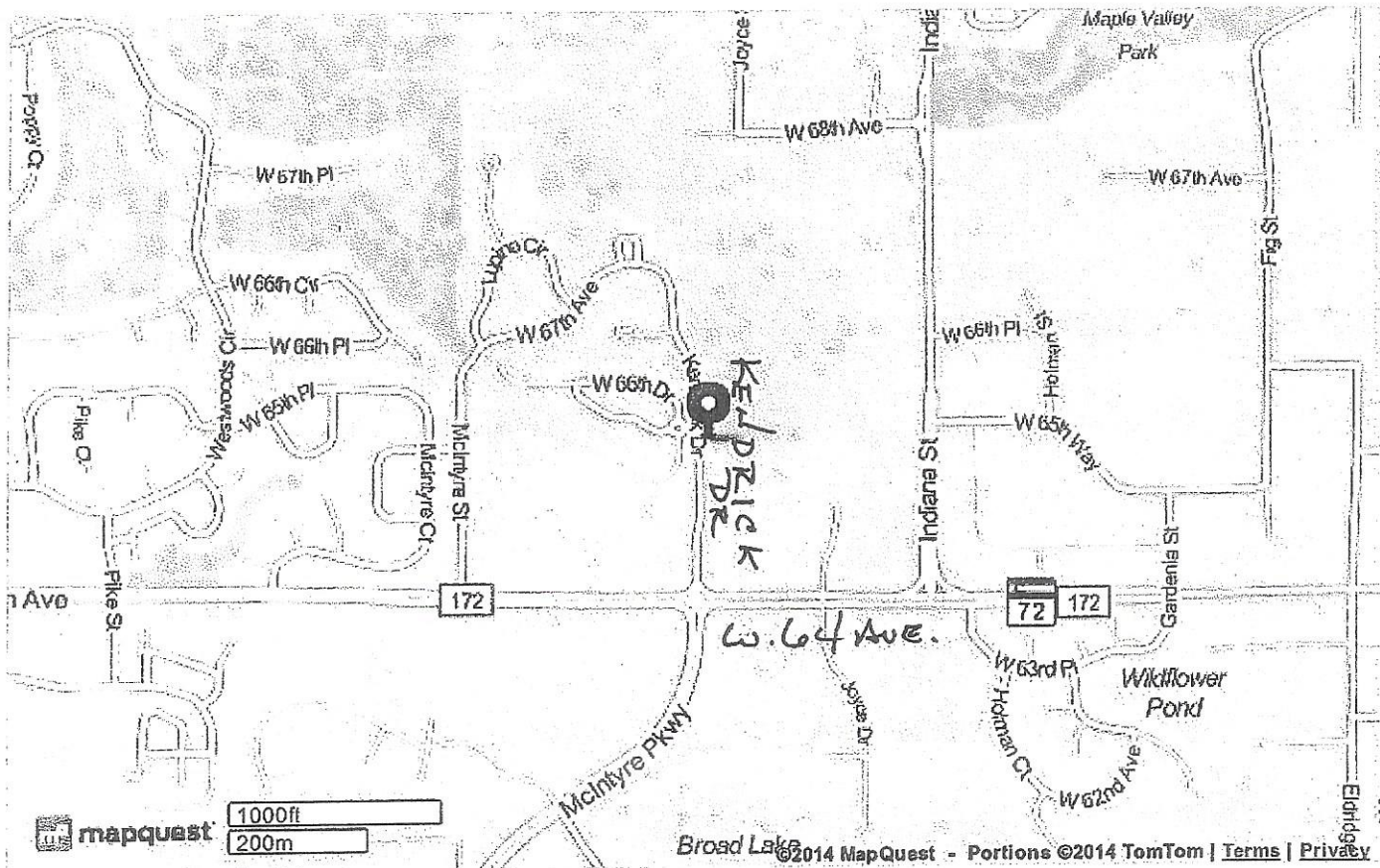
If taking Wadsworth, head west on W. 72nd Av to Ward Rd. Southbound on Ward Rd to west on 64th Ave to Kendrick Dr.

I-70 to Ward Road exit:

From I-25 go west onto I-70 approx 8 miles to Ward Road, Exit 266. Go north approx 1 1/4 mile to Ralston Road. Turn left onto Ralston. Ralston shortly becomes W. 64th Avenue. Go west approx 1 3/4 mile to Kendrick Drive. Turn right.

C-470 to I-70 then Ward Road:

From I-25 in Lone Tree, exit 194, go west onto C-470 which merges onto I-70. Trip will take approx 33 miles to Ward Road, exit 266. Go north on Ward Road approx 1 1/4 mile to Ralston Road. Turn left onto Ralston. Ralston shortly becomes W 64th Avenue. Go west approx 1 3/4 mile to Kendrick Drive, Turn right.
